OUR 2020 SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES

Online training isn't for everyone! Due to COVID-19, we are following these guidelines for our training camp events. We want you to attend AND feel safe. The hotel venues are practicing CDC and Health Department measures and AIHC is limiting the number attending to ensure social distancing.

- Bring a face-covering or mask. Wear it as you are entering the classroom, signing in and getting settled. You must wear a mask to attend one of our live events.
 - You may remove it after you are seated but wear it when speaking to others or walking about the room, etc.
- Everyone will be placed at least 6 feet apart. We have limited attendance to ensure the room is large enough so we can all keep our distance.
- Wash your hands frequently and use hand sanitizer made available in the classroom.
- Arrive 15 minutes prior to lecture to sign in as proof of attendance. We will give you your own pen to keep along with your training materials.
- Leave your laptop in your briefcase or room and do not use it in class.
- Keep your cell phone clean and don't text during class – step out of the room to make calls or text, then wash your hands before re-entering the room and use hand-sanitizer after re-entering if you touched the door handle.

Do not come if you are sick or have been exposed to someone testing positive for COVID-19 within the past 14 days– we can transfer you to the online course or make other special arrangements to help you train and certify when you are feeling better.
