



COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKERS NEEDED

Baltimore, MD

Summary

The Baltimore Health Corps will recruit, train, and employ more than 300 residents who are currently jobless due to the pandemic to serve as contact tracers, care coordinators, and Community Health Workers. Health Corps staff will be deployed to address critical COVID-19 needs in Baltimore's most vulnerable communities, performing three key functions: public health education outreach, contact tracing, and care coordination and social support.

Health Corps staff will be well-positioned for careers as certified community health workers at program conclusion, even if they have no previous experience in public health.

In addition, the Mayor's Office of Employment Development will provide career navigation, legal support, and mental health support to ensure staff are placed with employers and can overcome any long-term barriers to employment.

The city is recruiting 276 community health workers, including 38 supervisors, for these roles. In addition, there are 10 employment development, 7 managerial, and 10 administrative roles
