Summary

The Enterprise Architect will align IT strategy and planning with company's business goals, while optimizing information management approaches through an understanding of evolving business needs and technology capabilities

Responsibilities:

- Responsible for the definition, oversight, coordination and development of technology designs, along with the related road maps and lifecycle management
- Work with domain architects to provide enterprise solutions that are scalable, adaptable and in synchronization with ever changing business needs
- Provide overall architecture guidance, governance, and recommendations in support of business and technical objectives
- Manage risks associated with information and IT assets through appropriate standards and security policies
- Develop policies, standards and guidelines that direct the selection, development, implementation and use of Information Technology within the enterprise
- Build employee knowledge and skills in specific areas of expertise
- Deliver engaging, informative and well-organized information at all levels of business and technology organizations
- Effectively execute and communicate change management
- Apply principles of logical or scientific thinking to define problems, collect data, establish facts, and draw valid conclusions
- Interpret a variety of instructions and procedures in mathematical, diagrammatic, written, oral, and schedule forms
- Perform all other job related instructions as requested

Requirements

Education / Experience:

- Bachelor's degree in computer science or related field or equivalent years of relevant work experience is *required*
- Master's degree is *preferred*
- A minimum of seven (7) years of IT and/or relevant business experience, to include a minimum of one (1) year of experience as an architect, technical lead, or business analyst, and three (3) years of experience in a relevant domain, such as software engineering, systems engineering, infrastructure, network, storage, information management, organizational development, or business processes.
- Proven experience using enterprise architecture modeling tools and methodologies and delivery in both waterfall and agile SDLC methodologies, business process improvement, or lean six sigma, is *required*.

Required Competencies / Knowledge / Skills:

- Understanding of enterprise architectural frameworks, organizational frameworks, and/or business process frameworks
- Ability to conduct financial analysis for the purpose of making sound business decisions
- Knowledge of healthcare industry and technology for which the enterprise architecture is being developed
- Strong interpersonal and leadership skills
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills. Ability to communicate complex technical issues to non-technical audience Knowledge of IT governance and operations
- Comprehensive knowledge of hardware, software, application, process, and systems engineering
- Project and program management planning and organizational skills
- Ability to lead technical evaluations and conduct R&D in emerging technologies
- Ability to develop, prioritize and accomplish goals
