

Corporate Compliance Director

Summary

The Director of Compliance (“Director”) for All Children’s Hospital (“ACH”) is an individual who has a thorough understanding of products and services provided by ACH and all associated requirements for billing the products and services to governmental payers. The position has primary responsibility of conducting facility audits and overseeing, interpreting audit results for, and reporting professional services.

Responsibilities

- Monitoring new rules and regulations and advising in a timely fashion the relevant staff within ACH
- Report to the Johns Hopkins Health System Chief Compliance Officer.
- Independently assess a variety of complex compliance risk-areas within ACH to develop the JHHS Compliance Department’s work plan. This position is responsible for independently performing scheduled ACH facility audits required by the work plan, unplanned investigations and in carrying out these activities independently providing compliance guidance to ACH personnel.
- Use judgment and critical thinking in determining appropriate corrective actions for non-compliance as well as ensuring that corrective action is taken by the affiliate.
- Responsible for monitoring and responding to certain regulatory requests and representing the JHHS Compliance Department on various committees as requested.
- Communicate audit results to ACH management and monitoring any necessary systemic changes resulting from those audits.
- Provide regular guidance and advice to ACH personnel, leadership and Executive Management related to compliance matters.
- Conducts independent research in the areas of Medicare and Medicaid and other complex legal authorities pertaining to billing and regulatory compliance.
- Responsibilities include the development of education and training for management and staff regarding federal payor regulatory requirements and other compliance matters based on the incumbent’s independent judgment of the affiliate’s educational needs.
- Manage audits conducted by vendors and payers and provide regular status reports to senior management. Additionally
- Review the draft work product of peers and mentor and assist in the training and development of the compliance staff.

Qualifications

Education

- Bachelor's degree in Accounting, Business Administration, hospital administration, clinical or related discipline OR minimum 10 years of experience related to hospital billing compliance. Master's Degree *is preferred*.

Experience

- Work requires demonstrated experience with services provided in a hospital setting, and governmental relations as acquired during 10 years of progressively more responsible management experience.
