



Patient Safety Quality Innovation Coordinator

Summary

The Patient Safety Innovation Coordinator is responsible for the coordination of patient safety activities as outlined in the Hospital's Patient Safety Program. The position encompasses various roles (e.g., coordinator, educator) and requires effective interpersonal and management skills to motivate staff to embrace the Hospital's Patient Safety Program.

Responsibilities:

- Oversee the Hospital's Event Reporting System and will provide support to select committees that come under either the Hospital's Patient Safety Program, Regulatory Compliance Program and/or the Hospital's Performance Improvement Program.
- Work with hospital departments on risk reduction strategies to enhance patient safety.
- Responsible for effectively facilitating Comprehensive Unit-based Safety teams, and other organization wide performance improvement teams.

Qualifications

- Master's degree in related field required.
- Demonstrated experience in regulatory compliance, performance improvement, patient safety and data management required.
- Graduate of an accredited program of nursing.
- Two years college or business school, or 4 years of equivalent experience (in addition to the minimum 3 years required experience).
- Certification by the Association of Health Care Quality, The Joint Commission or other applicable professional organization preferred.
- If a licensed health care professional, must maintain current Maryland License or licensure in a compact state that allows practice in Maryland.
