Online, On-Demand Training - This course is Online, On-Demand with no scheduled classes to attend during your 6-month access to course materials. Optional Certification Exam – Earn the CIFHA Credential

Experienced Healthcare Executives, Human Resource Directors, Compliance Officers and Managers successfully completing this course have the *option* to certify as a Certified Internal Forensic Healthcare Auditor (CIFHASM). The online exam can be taken remotely from the comfort of your home or office. Attempts at the exam are only available by appointment with a professional AIHC proctor.

About the Certification Exam

- The exam is 100 questions, open note three (3) hour proctored exam taken online.
- Passing score is 80%*
- There are five (5) Domains:
 - Investigative Terminology, Abbreviations and Acronyms
 - How to Accept & Plan the Investigation
 - Using appropriate Investigative techniques, Collecting & Handling Potential Evidence
 - Conducting Investigative Interviews, Credibility & Detecting Deception
 - Analyzing Data, Burden of Proof & Writing the Report
- The exam is taken online from the comfort of your home or office by appointment only and scheduled with a professional AIHC proctor. Certification is approved by the Certification Exam Board.

***Policy:** The certification exam is optional, but the cost of one exam attempt is included in your course tuition provided you take the exam within three months of completing the program. Typical pass rate on 1 attempt when the exam is taken within 4 weeks after completing the course is 92%. If you do not pass the first time, you may purchase up to 2 additional attempts at certification totally 3 attempts within 1 year from your course enrollment date.

Maintaining Your CIFHA Credential

Once you are certified, you need to maintain your credential by earning six (6) CEUs annually. AIHC also offers free and low-cost CEU programs for our members.
