- Assist in the implementation of compliance and privacy initiatives, serving as a resource and providing guidance on privacy compliance related matters, including uses and disclosures of protected health information and personally identifiable information;
- Research, analyze, and interpret laws, regulations, and contracts; develop, review, and update policies and procedures; conduct routine or focused reviews for adherence to Federal, State, and local regulatory and contractual requirements, as well as organizational needs;
- Coordinate activities related to the implementation of compliance and privacy mandates (i.e. Federal
 and State laws and regulations (e.g. HIPAA, CMIA, 42 CFR Part 2, CA Welfare and Institutions
 Code)) and contractual agreements (e.g. Medi-Cal Social Services and Mental Health Services), including
 privacy risk assessments, audits, and the preparation of reports / metrics / dashboards
- Develop, review, and monitor implementation of corrective action plans to reduce risks; assist in conducting risk assessments to identify potential areas of compliance vulnerability and areas at high risk of non-compliance;
- Coordinate and/or manage the response to, and investigation of, privacy and security incidents and breaches of protected information; provide guidance or technical assistance and follow-up on mitigation and corrective action activities.
