Further, the CFO will be responsible for directing and overseeing primary accounting and finance functions for all departments or entities which includes general ledger accounting, internal financial reporting, financial planning (budgeting), financial analysis and pro-forma preparation of proposed Orthopedic Institute acquisitions and expansions and have direct oversight of the billing and collection process.
