POSITION SUMMARY:

Under the general supervision of the Manager, Special Investigations Unit (SIU), the Lead for the FWA Program is responsible for leading the day-to-day operations of IEHP's FWA and Conduct & Ethics Programs. The Lead provides oversight and quality assurance of intake, case investigations, corrective action, inquiries, and projects/initiatives involving the FWA and Conduct & Ethics Programs, while prioritizing and managing workload to meet internal performance metrics and regulatory and contractual requirements. The Lead works collaboratively with other IEHP business areas to ensure the proper oversight of IEHP's FWA and Conduct & Ethics Programs. The Lead is responsible to demonstrate IEHP's commitment to prevent, detect, and correct identified issues of potential or actual fraud, waste, and abuse in the healthcare environment and monitoring and maintaining a risk management framework to ensure audit readiness and compliance with the requirements set forth by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), the United States Health and Human Services Office of the Inspector General (HHS-OIG), the California Department of Managed Health Care (DMHC) and the California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS).

EXPERIENCE QUALIFICATIONS:

- Six (6) years of experience in Healthcare compliance in the area(s) of fraud prevention, detection, and correction, claims processing, billing, and coding, data mining or auditing and/or investigative techniques.
- Experience leading the day-to-day operations of a program and/or team.

EDUCATION/LICENSES/CERTIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution required (preferably in a related field).
- Master's degree from an accredited institution preferred.
- Professional certifications such as Accredited Healthcare Fraud Investigator (AHFI), Certified Fraud Examiner (CFE), or similar certification required.
