Opportunity:

The University of Toledo seeks an experienced and data-driven Chief Medical Information Officer (CMIO) to fulfill the institution's mission to improve the human condition and the community's health through education, research, and health care.

Dually reporting to the Chief Executive Officer of the University of Toledo Medical Center (UTMC) and the Chief Physician Executive of UToledo Health, the CMIO will lead the UT health enterprise IT efforts to advance clinical operations; ensure quality; transform care delivery; and optimize the patient, physician, and staff experience. The CMIO will provide business leadership and vision for the strategic planning, management, and implementation of information technology systems across the clinical enterprise.

The CMIO will establish strong partnerships with physicians across the health enterprise, deeply understanding their workflows and spearheading optimization efforts to enhance efficiency and drive positive clinical outcomes. The CMIO will bridge the gap between the clinical community and IT to communicate and align on challenges and strategic opportunities.

Qualifications:

The Chief Medical Information Officer will be a licensed, practicing, or non-practicing MD or DO with at least five years of relevant experience in a healthcare setting. Experience as an IT leader with broad-based, progressive IT leadership is essential. Experience with Epic EHR and state and federal policies and laws related to IT compliance, delivering and managing healthcare services is required.
