JOB SUMMARY:

Supports the Manager, Healthcare Compliance in developing, implementing, and maintaining the Healthcare Compliance Program for PeaceHealth. Assists with conducting and coordinating compliance investigations, annual work plan, and monitoring regulatory compliance across PeaceHealth systems. Responsible for identifying, assessing, and recommending corrective actions (including analyzing root causes and controls) regarding process-related issues in support of operational compliance with state and federal laws and regulations. Contributes to the development and maintenance of a compliance program in accordance with the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Inspector General (OIG), state and local regulations. Assists with Implementing and maintaining an effective organizational compliance program based upon the OIG's seven (7) elements of an effective compliance program and PeaceHealth policies.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Minimum of five years of compliance experience (within compliance or clinical departments) and/or experience in one or more of the following disciplines: Coding in a healthcare setting; Medical records management; Clinical setting; Education in the healthcare setting.

EDUCATION/LICENSES/CERTIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor's Degree or equivalent knowledge and skills obtained through a combination of education, training and experience.
- Required within 1-1/2 years: Certified in Healthcare Compliance
