JOB SUMMARY:

Supports the Compliance Department with the facilitation and administration of compliance activities related to the operation of the compliance program. Performs reviews, research, data analysis and investigations, tracks and analyzes compliance activities, and prepares compliance and regulatory educational materials. This specific role will perform audits and proactive monitoring strategies to monitor for discrepant use of medications. Maintains required records and educates medical center staff on requirements and best practices. In addition, the Drug Diversion Program Analyst will prepare written reports and presentations of data analysis as directed.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Typically requires 3 years of experience in a health care environment that includes experiences with health care regulatory requirements.
