JOB SUMMARY:

The Regulatory Compliance Clinical Auditor is responsible for performing regulatory compliance activities which include assessing compliance with The Joint Commission (TJC) standards, Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) Conditions of Participation, OSHA/FDA/CDC guidelines, HIPAA and EMTALA law, and other external regulatory requirements. Additionally, assessing compliance with facility internal policies through concurrent and retrospective chart review, observing of clinical and operational performance (tracer methodology), and data collection and analysis. Responsibilities include mock survey activities designed to mirror anticipated accreditation, certification or licensure surveys.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- A minimum of two (2) years equivalent full-time clinical experience as RN, LPN, PA, or experience in related or allied health care field collecting and analyzing data, preparing reports, identifying and solving problems and conducting educational programs with hospital staff, etc.
- Prior experience in regulatory compliance strongly preferred.
- Relevant experience in a health care setting with experience in data collection and analysis preferred.
