JOB SUMMARY:

Reporting to the Manager of Compliance audit, the Corporate Compliance Regulatory Analyst plays a critical role in ensuring Rush University System for Health (Rush) maintains the highest standards of regulatory compliance across the system. This position is responsible for conducting comprehensive audits to ensure alignment with federal and state regulations as well as Rush's internal policies. The Analyst collaborates closely with hospital departments and Rush Medical Group (RMG) to identify, analyze, and resolve compliance related issues, minimizing organizational risk and promoting operational integrity. With a high degree of independence, the Analyst manages both individual and team projects, demonstrating exceptional attention to detail and high level of accuracy. The analyst must have knowledge of CMS conditions of participation, conditions of payment, teaching physician guidelines, and false claims. The individual should exemplify the Rush mission, vision and values and act in accordance with Rush policies and procedures.
