Responsibilities:

- Perform interface analysis, build, performance monitoring, and reporting to ensure standardization, consistency, and efficiency across the South Shore Health enterprise
- Develop, build, and maintain interfaces between applications and databases, including Epic and Workday systems
- Facilitate collaboration with user departments and vendors to define interface requirements, specifications, and project scope
- Prepare and recommend technical documentation required to successfully implement and support assigned projects
- Work with end users and IT staff to develop procedures for monitoring interfaces and maintaining optimal system performance
- Develop and monitor testing methodologies and implementation plans to validate interface functionality and reliability
- Maintain and update interface specification documentation and assist with technical documentation, conversion plans, and operational training materials
- Provide troubleshooting and support for integration issues in a 24/7 healthcare environment

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in Computer Science or related field, or an equivalent combination of education and information systems experience
- Minimum of 2 years of professional interface development experience in a healthcare environment
- Proficiency with Rhapsody or another integration engine, with experience developing and maintaining enterprise system interfaces
- Experience with Epic Bridges and Workday interfaces preferred, including integrations across clinical and operational systems
- Experience with Cleo or other SFTP solutions, APIs, and familiarity with healthcare data exchange and integration standards preferred
- Knowledge of HIPAA, JCAHO, and other healthcare regulations, with strong analytical, organizational, communication skills and the ability to participate in 24/7 on-call support as needed
