This position works with the Compliance Officer on audits, policies and procedures, training, and regulatory reporting by performing the following duties.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- Related experience required as an investigator, paralegal, professional coder, or auditor in the health care industry.
- Job requires specialized computer skills.
- Must be adept at using various applications including database, spreadsheet, report writing, project management, graphics, word processing, presentation creation/editing, communicate by e-mail and use scheduling software.
